Fiction

- Connelly, Michael *The Fifth Witness*- Mickey Haller takes on a foreclosure defense only to have his client accused of killing the banker she blames for trying to take away her home. (5th in the Mikey Haller Series)
- Franklin, Tom *Crooked Letter, Crooked Letter*- in Mississippi, a black constable must investigate his white boyhood friend when a girl goes missing.
- Grissom, Kathleen *Kitchen House* - Working as an indentured servant alongside slaves, a 7-year-old Irish girl finds her light skin places her between two very different worlds.
- Lutz, Lisa & Hayward, David *Heads You Lose* - Pot-growing siblings investigate why a headless corpse has turned up on their property.
- Nicholls, David *One Day* - Emma and Dexter get together (almost) in 1988. Catch up with them and their relationship annually on July 15 over the next 20 years.
- Patterson, Richard North *In the Name of Honor* - One of the army's most accomplished young lawyers must defend a general's son who recently returned from a harrowing tour in Iraq.
- Singer, Randy *Justice Game* - When the family of a shooting victim sues the manufacturer of the gun used by the killer, the case's lawyers are targeted with blackmail.
- Vincenzi, Penny *No Angel* - Family saga starring a smart, ambitious woman working against stereotypes during World War I (1st in the **Spoils of Time** trilogy).
- Winspear, Jacqueline *Maisie Dobbs Novels*- Follow Maisie Dobbs, a "psychologist and investigator," who solves mysteries in post World War I London..
- Wolitzer, Meg *The Uncoupling*- When a drama teacher decides on "Lysistrata" for the high school play, the women in the town begin to refuse to have sex.

Non- Fiction

- Leavy, Jane *The Last Boy* - A candid portrait of Mickey Mantle that tells both of his accomplishments in baseball and his difficult private life.
- Biegel, Brian *Miracle Ball* – The author describes his quest to find the legendary, long-missing, 1951 pennant-winning home run baseball, hit by the Giants’ Bobby Thomson.
- Lagnado, Lucette *The Man in the White Sharkskin Suit* - The story of a Jewish family’s exodus from Cairo to New York, after the 1956 Nasser coup.
- Lanctot, Neil *Campy* – Traces the life and career of the Roy Campanella, from playing in the Negro Leagues to the accident that rendered him a quadriplegic.
- Larson, Erik *In the Garden of the Beast* – Documents the efforts of the first American ambassador to Hitler's Germany to acclimate to life in an increasingly violent city
- Summerscale, Kate *The Suspicions of Mr. Whicher*– Traces the 1860 murder of a young child whose death launched a national obsession with detection throughout England.
