Anton, Maggie	<b>Rashi's Daughters</b> (Book I- Joheved; Book II-Miriam; Book III- Rachel) – Historical series about three sisters, daughters of a Jewish scholar, living in the eleventh-century.
Connelly, Michael	<b>The Brass Verdict</b> - After inheriting a high-profile defense from a murdered colleague, a lawyer reluctantly teams up with LAPD detective to solve the crime. (Mickey Haller Series #2, Harry Bosch Mysteries #14)
Flynn, Gillian	<i>Gone Girl</i> - When a woman goes missing her husband, a suspect, realizes that something more disturbing than murder may have occurred.
Hannah, Kristin	<i>Night Road</i> . A disadvantaged teen finds friendship, acceptance and love with a prosperous Seattle-area family, until a tragic accident changes everything.
Landay, William	<b>Defending Jacob</b> – When his 14 year old son is charged with the murder of a fellow student an assistant district attorney is torn between loyalty and justice.
Moehringer, J.R.	<i>Sutton</i> – A fictionalized account of the life of Willie Sutton, one of the most notorious bank robbers in American history.
Morton, Kate	<i>The Secret Keeper</i> - Visiting her dying mother, a famous actress is plagued by the memory of her mother killing a man which begins her investigation into past secrets.
Richman, Alyson	<b>Rhythm of Memory</b> – Falling in love as students in Chile, a couple must escape to Sweden after their opposition to a brutal dictator puts them in grave danger.
Stachniak, Eva	<i>The Winter Palace</i> – Traces the story of two young women: Barbara, a servant who becomes a royal spy and Sophia, a naive duchess who becomes Catherine the Great.

Bennett, Tony	<i>Life Is a Gift</i> - In this collection of reflections from his life and career, musical icon Bennett tells stories of friends and family and the lessons they have taught him.
Feldman, Deborah	<b>Unorthodox</b> - Traces the author's upbringing in a Hasidic community in Brooklyn and her struggle to leave and forge her own path in life.
Fisher, Robin Gaby & Gugliermo, Angelo J.	<i>The Woman Who Wasn't There</i> - The story of one of the most famous September 11 survivors who wasn't really there when the towers fell.
Guiliano, Mireille	<i>French Women Don't Get Fat</i> – Unlocks the simple secrets of the "French paradox" – how they enjoy food while staying slim and healthy.
Phillips, Mackenzie	High On Arrival – The teen star of One Day at a Time tells of growing up with the legendary John Phillips of The Mamas & the Papas and her battle with addiction.
Rogers, Kenny	<i>Luck or Something Like It</i> - Musician Kenny Rogers shares his memories, from growing up in Depression-era Texas through his 50 years in the music business
Sacks, Oliver	<i>Hallucinations</i> – A neurologist weaves together stories of his patients and of his own mind-altering experiences to illuminate what hallucinations tell us about the brain.
Schroff, Laura & Tresniowski, Alex	<b>An Invisible Thread</b> — The story of an unlikely friendship between a sales executive and an 11 year old panhandler and how the relationship changed their lives.
Skloot, Rebecca	<i>The Immortal Life of Henrietta Lacks</i> – The story of a cell line used in research around the world and the woman from whom the cells were taken.
