Users

The Library serves a population of 52,102, an estimated 17,671 households. There are 22,864 registered borrowers, 42,811 people visited our website and 317,424 people came through our door!

Programs and Services

There were 1,238 programs and 54,005 of your neighbors attended. Did you? What about the summer reading club? A total of 9,230 children, teens and adults took part. Did you miss it?

There are computers here for your use, and secure public Wi-fi for your own device.

Collections

The Library owns 289,703 print materials, 68,287 e-books, 87 databases, 9,662 downloadable audio books, and 27,224 films, audio-books and music cd's. Library staff added 31,195 of these materials throughout the year.

During this fiscal year, we circulated 464,265 items and were open 3,364 hours which means we circulated 138 items per hour.

We borrowed 30,080 items from other libraries for your use and loaned 48,442 items to other libraries' patrons.
