



ADULT SUMMER READING CLUB FAQS

What is the Adult Summer Reading Club?

It is an event for Nassau County library cardholders, 21 years or older, that rewards summer readers with parties and prizes.

When and where can I sign up?

Registration begins on **Thursday June 7th**. Our sign-up is in the lobby from 11:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. The Summer Reading Kickoff Party begins at 7:30 that evening with guest author Judy Blundell who will be speaking about her new novel **The High Season**. Copies will be available for purchase. After that date, you can register anytime at the Reference Desk or on the Summer Reading Club website at <https://tinyurl.com/emlibrariesrock>. Please choose to either enroll and review online or to enroll and submit reviews at the Reference Desk. **Signup ends August 7th and August 14th is the last day to submit reviews and other forms.**

How do I participate?

When you read a book, a book report must be filled out and dropped at the Reference Desk or filled out online at our website. Every report becomes a ticket that you will use to win prizes at our “End of Summer Wish It Were Longer” Party. **Only books read between June 7th and August 14th can be reviewed.** Please limit your reviews to **no more than seven (7) reports a week.** Another way of getting tickets is to attend our Reader Services Summer Events. An extra ticket will be awarded if you participated in last year’s program. If you submit the tic-tac-toe form you will receive 3 extra tickets. Small prizes will be drawn from submitted reviews throughout the summer and winners will be notified.

Please note, we will not accept book reviews on travel guides, cookbooks, children’s books, magazines or similar material at our discretion. Ebooks and audiobooks are welcome.

What happens to your reviews?

We would love to share your reviews with others. At registration, we will ask your permission to do so.

How do I get invited to the party?

You must turn in at least two (2) book report forms to get an invitation to the party.

When is the party?

The party will be held Tuesday, August 21st in the downstairs community room.
