- All We Ever Wanted*** by Emily Giffin- A woman is devastated when her son is accused of sending a sexually explicit picture.
- An American Marriage*** by Tayari Jones- A marriage is tested when the husband is mistakenly convicted and imprisoned.
- Artemis*** by Andy Weir- A smuggler in the only city on the moon is asked to sabotage a mining operation.
