

## Directions to Interim Programming Spaces from East Meadow Public Library

### Calvary Lutheran Church

36 Taylor Ave, East Meadow, NY 11554

Northeast on Front St. - Turn right onto Hempstead Turnpike, (pass the 7-11 on your right).  
Just before Wantagh Parkway entrance, turn right onto Taylor Ave. The Church is on your right.

### Cradle of Aviation

Charles Lindbergh Blvd, Garden City, NY 11530

Travel North on East Meadow Ave. Turn left onto Hempstead Turnpike for .6 miles.  
Turn right onto Merrick Ave for .5 miles. Turn left onto Charles Lindbergh Blvd. for 1 mile.  
The Cradle of Aviation will be on your right. It is near the Children's Museum, the Firemen's Museum,  
and the Carousel.

### East Meadow Jewish Center

1400 Prospect Ave, East Meadow, NY 11554

South on East Meadow Ave. for .5 miles. Turn right on Prospect Ave., stay on Prospect for .7 miles.  
The Synagogue is on your left. Parking is in back.

### East Meadow United Methodist Church

470 East Meadow Ave., East Meadow, NY

Go South on East Meadow Ave. for .6 miles. The Church is on your right, after the East Meadow  
Post Office. There is parking behind the Church, via Harton Ave and Bernard St.

### Hofstra University

In the Joseph Shapiro Family Hall, Room 302, 3rd floor.  
160 Hofstra University Hempstead NY 11549 US, Hempstead, NY

### Nassau Library System

900 Jerusalem Ave, Uniondale, NY 11553

Travel West on Front Street for .6 miles. Turn left onto Merrick Ave for 1.2 miles.  
Turn right onto North Jerusalem Road for 1 mile. (this turns into Jerusalem Road).  
900 Jerusalem Ave. is on your left. It is next to Grace Church.

### East Meadow Benevolent Hall

170 Maple Ave, East Meadow, NY 11554

Travel time approximately 5 minutes. Head southwest on Front St. Turn left onto Maple Ave.  
Benevolent Hall will be on the right.

### Senator Speno Memorial Park

745 East Meadow Ave, East Meadow, NY 11554

Take East Meadow Ave. South. Travel time approximately 5 minutes.  
Speno Park will be on the left.

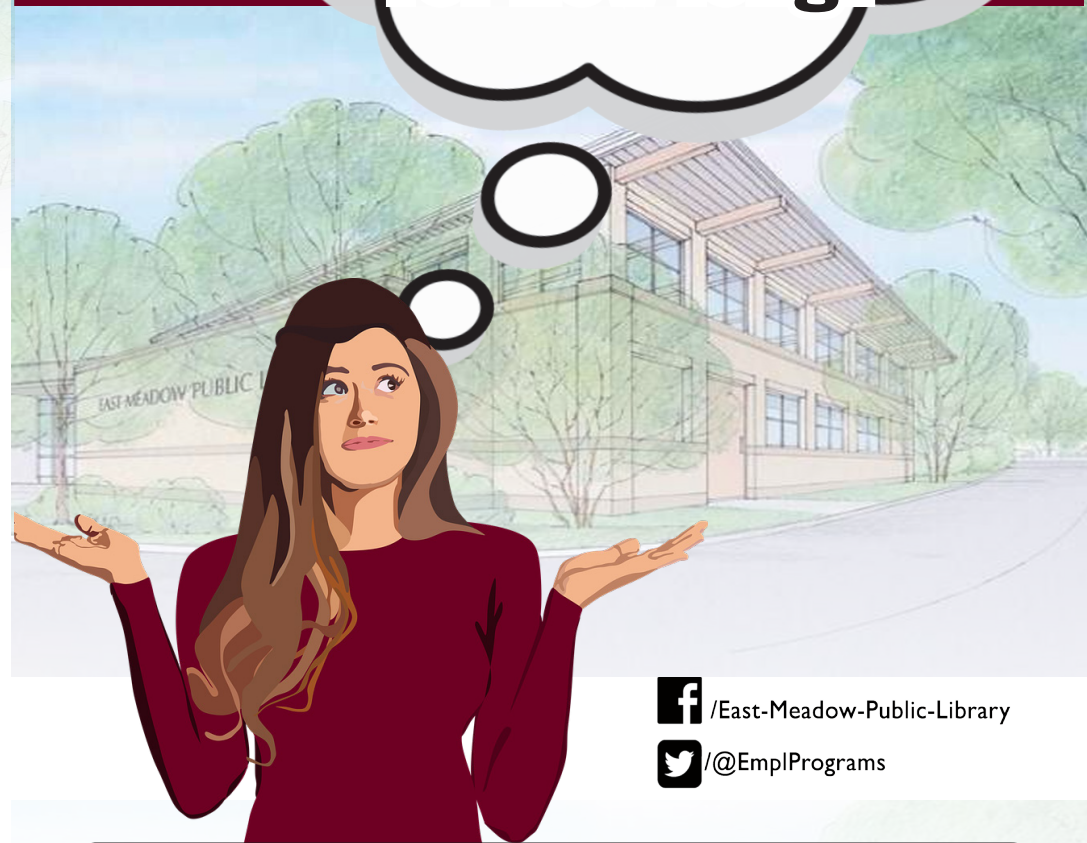

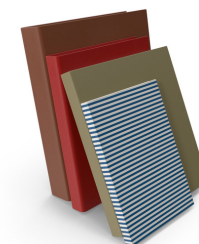
