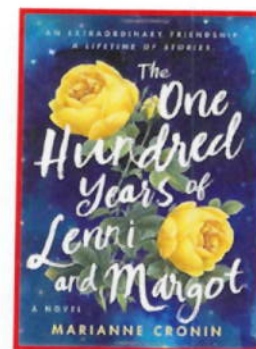

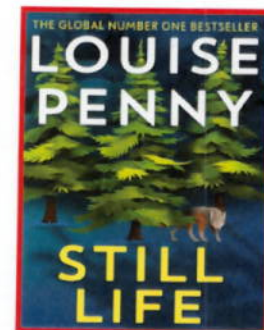


IT'S A MYSTERY BOOK CLUB
