DeLozier, Elizabeth Eleanore of Avignon – In 1347 Provence, a midwife becomes an apprentice to the Pope's physician in the shadow of the Black Death and accusations of witchcraft.

> **James**— In this retelling of *Huckleberry Finn*, the enslaved Jim overhears that he is about to be sold and decides to hide until he can formulate a plan.

This is How It Always Is – When the youngest of five boys says he wants to be a girl, a family makes difficult choices that have unexpected consequences.

**Blue Hour -** On an isolated Scottish island, a present-day discovery intimately connects three people and unveils a web of secrets and lies from the past.

A Family Matter – After the father who raised her receives a terminal diagnosis, a woman discovers that what she knows about why her mother left may not be true.

Atmosphere-In 1980, a scientist is selected to become a member of the Space Shuttle program and finds unexpected love which is threatened when a mission goes wrong.

The American Daughters - Enslaved in New Orleans, a girl meets a free Black woman and joins a clandestine society of spies after she is separated from her mother.

After Happily Ever – In midlife, three fairytale princesses find that life is not as perfect as they imagined and are thrust into personal quests that redefine their lives.

Count My Lies - A woman who lies constantly ends up as a nanny for a wealthy family, but all is not as perfect as it first seems in her new life.

**Tell Me Everything** – Town lawyer Bob Burgess falls into a deep friendship with writer, Lucy Barton, and together they meet the iconic Olive Kitteridge in this novel that brings together the beloved characters from many of the author's other novels. (Olive Kitteridge, Olive, Again, The Burgess Boys, My Name is Lucy Barton, Anything Is Possible, Oh William!, Lucy by the Sea)

Eilis Lacey Series - Follows a young Irish woman who immigrates to Brooklyn in the 1950s and then moves to Long Island after marrying into a close Italian-American family. (*Brooklyn* and *Long Island*)
