



Santi's Pick: *Midnight Run* (1988) Dir. Martin Brest





### Michael's Pick: *The Good, The Bad, and The Ugly* (1966) Dir. Sergio Leone



### Justin's Pick: *Lost Highway* (1997) Dir. David Lynch


