What is the Adult Summer Reading Club?

It is an event for Nassau County library cardholders, 19 years or older, that rewards summer readers with a party and prizes.

When and where can I sign up? When does it end?

The first sign-up day is **Monday June 8th**. You will be able to sign up online at <https://emlibny10.readsquared.com/>, or in-person in the lobby from 10 am -12 pm, or 1:30 pm – 4:30 pm. After June 8th, you can also register at the Reference Desk. Our Kickoff event will be Pub Quiz Night in the Library, beginning at 7:00 pm that night. We will serve up a night of fun and tricky trivia around our theme “Unearth A Story.” **Reading Club sign-up ends Monday, July 27th**.

How do I participate?

When you read or listen to a book, a book report form must be submitted online at the Reading Club website (<https://emlibny10.readsquared.com/>), or filled out and dropped into the Reference Desk box. The reviews that you submit will be automatically recorded in our log as points, and will increase your chances of winning prizes at our End of Summer Wish it Were Longer party. **Only books read between June 8th and August 2nd can be reviewed. The first day reviews are accepted is Monday June 15th, and Monday August 2nd is the last day reviews are accepted.** Please limit your reviews to **no more than seven (7) reports a week.**

Extra ways to earn points are to attend our Reader Services Summer Events and complete the tic-tac-toe form in your packet. Small prizes will be drawn from submitted reviews throughout the summer and winners will be notified.

Please note, we will not accept book reviews on travel guides, cookbooks, children’s books, magazines or similar material at our discretion. Ebooks and audiobooks are welcome.

What happens to your reviews?

We would love to share your reviews with others. At registration, we will ask your permission to do so.

How do I get invited to the party?

You must turn in at least two (2) book report forms to get an invitation to the party.

When is the party?

The party will be held Tuesday, August 11.
