



Justin's Pick: *Spider-Man* (2002) Dir. Sam Raimi

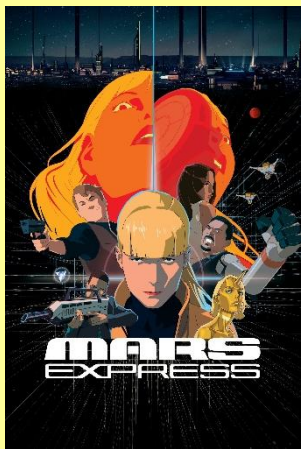

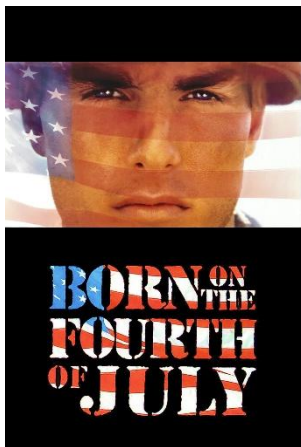

Matt's Pick: *Jojo Rabbit* (2019) Dir. Taika Waititi

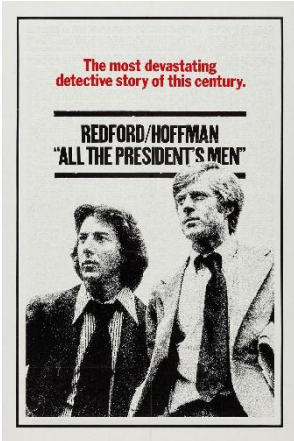

Michele's Pick: *All the President's Men* (1976) Dir. Alan Pakula

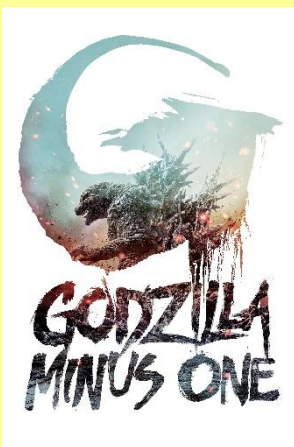

Vinny's Pick: *Apollo 13* (1995) Dir. Ron Howard

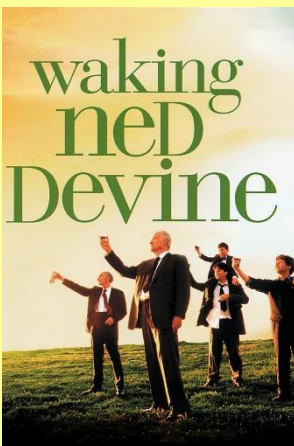
