Arnold, Mallory	<i>How to Survive a Horror Story</i> – A group of authors are invited to the will reading of a famed horror novelist, only to find themselves trapped in a deadly game.
Bell, A. D.	<i>The Bookbinder's Secret</i> – In 1901, an apprentice bookbinder is drawn into a dangerous mystery when she finds a decades old letter in an old burned book.
Benedict, Marie	<i>A Pair of Aces</i> – Two trailblazing women on opposite sides of the law team up to bring down notorious Mob boss Lucky Luciano in 1930s New York.
Burke, Caro Claire	<i>Yesteryear</i> - A wife and mother, who sells her fantasy pioneer lifestyle to her many followers, suddenly wakes in the year 1855 and must discover what is going on.
Davis, Viola & Patterson, James	<i>Judge Stone</i> – In a small Alabama town, a judge who also runs her family farm presides over a controversial case where the law is clear, but the morality is not.
Genova, Lisa	<i>More or Less Maddy</i> – A college student with bipolar disorder struggles to find her way in her new reality and navigates the complex effects it has on her life and future.
Grissom, Kathleen	<i>Crow Mary</i> – A novel based on a true story about an Indigenous woman who is wed to a white fur trader and endures a long journey from Montana to Saskatchewan.
Gutsch, J.M. & Maxim, Leo	<i>Frankie</i> – After being injured, a stray cat who wants nothing to do with humans forms an unlikely bond with a grieving widower who has given up on life.
Harmel, Kristin	<i>The Stolen Life of Colette Marceau</i> - Decades after WWII, a jewel thief must revisit the past when a familiar diamond bracelet, last seen with her sister, appears in a museum.
Heath, Sue	<i>The Storytellers</i> – In a library, a flyer for a writing competition draws four people together and they come to discover that a good story can open up your eyes and your world.
Hepworth, Sally	<i>Mad Mabel</i> – A cantankerous 81-year-old woman, who was convicted of murder when she was 15, finds her quiet life interrupted when a neighbor ends up dead.
Howard, Catherine Ryan	<i>The Nothing Man</i> – A woman who, as a child, was the only survivor of a murderous attack on her family is obsessed with identifying the man who destroyed her life.
Johnson, Craig	<i>Longmire Mysteries</i> - Gritty stories set in insular Absaroka County, WY, featuring sheriff Walt Longmire, a kindly Vietnam vet, and his idiosyncratic crew.
King, Crystal	<i>The Happiness Collector</i> - In modern Italy, a desperate historian accepts a mysterious cataloging job, only to discover her employers are ancient gods erasing human history.

Kline, Christina Baker	<i>The Foursome</i> – A reimagining of the true story of Kline’s distant relatives: two sisters who, in 19th-century North Carolina, married world-famous conjoined twins from Siam.
Kubica, Mary	<i>She’s Not Sorry</i> – A nurse, trying to balance career and motherhood, finds her life complicated while caring for a young woman who supposedly jumped from a bridge.
Levi, Allen	<i>Theo of Golden</i> – A stranger to a small town buys a local artist’s portraits, only to return them to the subject and, with each encounter, a story is told and a life altered.
Mason, Daniel	<i>North Woods</i> – Across the centuries, a humble cabin in the woods will become the home of an extraordinary succession of human and nonhuman characters.
McMahon, Jackie	<i>The Cloak and Dagger Club</i> – In 1930s London, a debut author is invited by the king of crime fiction to join his elite group of writers and ends up trying to solve his murder.
Minato, Kanae	<i>Confessions</i> – A teacher resigns after her daughter dies, but before she goes, she gives a lecture that sets in motion a diabolical plot for revenge against two of her students.
Moreno-Garcia, Silvia	<i>The Intrigue</i> – A handsome con artist thinks he has the perfect victim in a Veracruz boardinghouse owner, but she may not be the desperate spinster he believes her to be.
Page, Libby	<i>This Book Made Me Think of You</i> – A widow discovers her late husband left her one last birthday gift: twelve books to help her through her first year without him.
Perri, Camille	<i>Social Animals</i> – In a dog park, three very different women form a connection, but not all is what it seems. Will these friendships survive when secrets are revealed?
Searles, John	<i>Single Girls</i> – A fictionalized account of the iconic Helen Gurley Brown’s early years at the helm of Cosmopolitan magazine and of the “single girls” she hires.
